

Rotary members who wish to wage peace can use district grants and Rotary Foundation global grants to support projects with other Rotary members that help refugees and displaced people, provide medical support, and more worldwide. Members can also work with or join peaace-focused Rotary Action Groups, Friendship Exchanges, Fellowships, and intercountry committees. And District Designated Funds or district cash can support our peacebuilding and conflict prevention efforts.

Members and nonmembers alike can learn more about peacebuilding through the Rotary Positive Peace Academy, a free online course available to anyone with an internet connection. You can find it at **positivepeace.academy/rotary.** 


There is no denying that incidents of violence and atrocities being perpetuated around the world seem to be escalating. Global peace is fragile, and the stakes are getting higher.

# रोटरीच्या स्थापनकर्त्याला एक श्रद्धांजली

27 जानेवारी 1947

#### 19 एप्रिल 1868 ते 27 जानेवारी 1947

1947 हे सर्व भारतीयांसाठी अविस्मरणीय वर्ष आहे कारण यावर्षी आपल्याला स्वातंत्र्य मिळाले. त्याचप्रमाणे २६ जानेवारी हा देखील सर्व भारतीयांसाठी अत्यंत महत्त्वाचा दिवस आहे कारण या दिवशी भारतीय घटना अस्तित्वात आली.

जगातील सर्व रोटेरियन्स करता २७ जानेवारी १९४७ हा दिवस तसाच महत्त्वाचा आहे. या दिवशी रोटरीचे संस्थापक पोल हॅरीस यांचे वयाच्या ७८ व्या वर्षी निधन झाले. शिकागो येथील माऊंट होप या ख्रिश्चनांच्या दफनभूमीत त्यांचे अंत्यसंस्कार झाले.

त्यांनी त्यांच्या तीन मित्रांबरोबर 1905 साली स्थापित केलेल्या रोटरी क्लब या संस्थेचे त्यांच्या मृत्यूसमयी एका प्रचंड वटवृक्षात रूपांतर झाले होते. त्यावेळेस, जवळपास दोन लाख सदस्य संख्या असलेले रोटरी क्लब सुमारे 75 देशांमध्ये आपले सामाजिक कार्य करत होते. अर्थात त्यानंतर सध्या आजच्या घडीला, अंदाजे 14 लाख सदस्य संख्या असलेली रोटरी इंटरनॅशनल ही संस्था जगातील जवळपास प्रत्येक देशात काम करत आहे. सहवास आणि मैत्री या दोन मुख्य कारणांकरता सुरू झालेला रोटरीचा प्रवास आज बऱ्याच दिशांना जोमाने सुरू आहे.
